A district effort to keep students learning



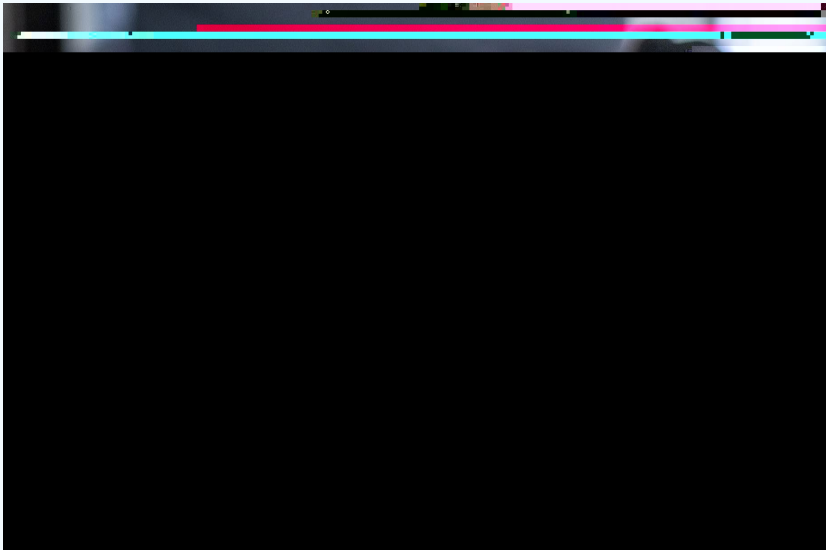
- Communicate with families regarding communicable disease transmission in our community.
